Training:

Crews continue to work on enhancing their skills and education. We have several people enrolled in wildland classes and are getting ready to put on our annual fire line refresher classes.

Cochise County OEM will be hosting a Hazardous Materials Technician class in Sierra Vista in the near future and we have had a couple of employees express interest in attending. This would be at minimal cost to the fire district.

Web Site:

The fire district does have a new web site www.sunsitesfiredept.com. With this new site comes a new way for the district to reach out to the community and to keep everyone informed.

Fire Prevention:

Capt. Waters will be looking into initiating some new life safety programs in the coming future. We have asked for the following to be initiated:

- 1. Elderly fall prevention program
- 2. Bi-annual in class fire safety education program
- 3. Monthly public service safety announcements
- 4. Increased awareness in the districts lock box program

Wildland:

Lt. Tingle and FF. Hershey will be working on a seasonal wildland program that will incorporate members of the community, the fire district as well as surrounding fire districts. This program promises to increase interoperability between area fire districts as well as get the community more involved in the fire district.

Haz-Mat team:

The county has expressed interest in SPFD joining the counties HAZ-MAT response team. At present this team is made up of personnel and equipment from various fire districts including Fry, City of Sierra Vista, and City of Douglas. This would be of great benefit to the county since there is no HAZMAT team members remotely close to this area as well as to the district and community by increasing our response parameters and abilities.

Maintenance:

At present,

E-308 remains out of service with a bad pump motor.

M-301 has been down sporadically due to battery issue that has now been corrected.

E-307 is being fitted with a new block heater by City of Sierra Vista fleet maintenance department.

M-302, M-303, E-307, E-305 remain to have small fluid leaks. No other issues noted with these or any other units.

SOP/SOG:

A SOP committee has been put together to go through and clean up and reword some of the fire districts SOP's and SOG's. This will clean up some of the vague gray areas and make the SOP's less confusing and not so open to interpretation.

Attached you will find the districts credit card form. This form holds the fire district harmless in the event an employee with a district credit card is found to have made unauthorized purchases. This will allow the district the ability to garnish the at fault employees pay for the amount of said charges. An SOP is also being developed for credit card use.

All the SOP's will be redistributed to the board upon completion for approval.

Communications:

The Dos Cabezas repeater is now repaired. It was found to have been struck by lightning and also had a faulty lighting suppressor switch. The unit has been rebuilt and the faulty switch replaced.

Donations:

On 1/5/2012 the fire district received a box of 430 AA batteries and 80 AAA batteries from the National Volunteer Fire Council and Duracell Batteries. Our thanks go out to both of those organizations for their assistance.
