placed on a future agenda. The Fire District Board cannot discuss or take legal action on any issue raised during the Call to the Public due to restrictions of the Open Meeting Law.

In addition, pursuant to the Bylaws of the Sunsites Pearce Fire District Article III, Section 2, Rule 2, F, Conduct of Meetings regarding the Limitation of Debate, No Member of the Board or Public shall be allowed to speak more than once upon any one subject until all Board Members have had an opportunity to speak. No Member of the Board or the public shall be allowed to speak for a period longer than three minutes without the leave of the presiding officer. Citizen groups shall identify themselves and shall be represented in presentation to the Board by one of the members of the group and cumulative or redundant speeches to the Board on the same issue shall be terminated at the discretion of the presiding officer.
