- 3. Our gurneys have undergone a biannual maintenance and are all functioning appropriately.
- 4. We have received another donation of Gatorade from PepsiCo and we cannot thank them enough.
- 5. Our med room wall has been replaced due to mold. We just need some finishing touches.
- 6. Decals have been ordered for the wheelchair van and water supply trailer and will be on soon.
- 7. We auctioned some surplus items locally and received \$605.65
- 8. Tender is on Public Surplus and for sale. Auction ends November 28th, 2014
- 9. We took delivery of our Fire Prevention Trailer on November 11, 2014 from Surrey fire Safety. The trailer is amazing and we hope to educate as much of the community as we can.
