- 1. On duty crews have been completing weekly training sessions. These sessions included: Engine inventory and pumping operations, vehicle inventory and operations, SCBA operations and checks, daily weather briefing, and 6 minutes of safety, SCBA breathe down drills and circuits, air quality monitor calibration, ropes, mechanical advantage calculations.
- 2. Target Solutions topics: Managing cardiac arrest, OSHA compliance.
- 3. We hosted Base Hospital continuing education on January 9, 2019. We covered stroke, diabetes, LVAD, and special populations/vulnerable persons.
- 4. We completed our annual wildland refresher and pack test on January 12, 2019.

5. Our hiring team, Captains Hershey, Garner, Tingle, and I completed the CJIS refresher. This training is maintaining compliance for DPS and FBI fingerprint background checks.

Wildland:

1. We have had no additional Wildland assignments since the last meeting. We have a total of \$11,141.81 billed to the Arizona Department of Forestry and Fire Management.

Out of District Fires:

1. We currently have a balance of \$64,777.67 outstanding for 27 fires that occurred outside of the district boundaries since 2012. Of the out of district fires, nine incidents, with a total of \$29,210.37 are in collections. Total unpaid balance that is not in collections is \$35,567.30.

Emergency Medical Services:

January total billings to date are \$46,120.83

Hazardous Materials:

- 1. We responded with Southwest gas to a natural gas leak at a residence.
- 2. We participated in the quarterly hazmat training in Willcox on January 24, 2019. We did utilize our hazmat trailer.

Maintenance:

- 1. M-303; Batteries failed, warrantied and replaced at no additional cost.
- 2. HazMat 30; The wiring harness was replaced, and all lights are working properly.

Communication:

- 1. On site fuel tanks: We have received the information needed through SOCO. We are now looking for a less expensive base options for the tanks. The electrical quote is \$720.
- 2. Richland Station vandalism update: I am still seeking a contractor to repair the doors.
- 3. The fire hydrant committee: We are working with Clear Springs Utility in publishing our new ISO rating.
- 4. Cochise County Health Department: We are hoping to conduct a clinic in early 2019.
- 5. Windsong dump site: I have spoken to the property owners and have authorization to burn the site when we are able.
- 6. We are working with the Northern Cochise Community Hospital on a radio use agreement. We are hoping to place one of our mobile radios in the emergency
