- 4. M301 died again while on a call and was towed to the shop. I have authorized the approx. \$6,500 quote for repair. Based on mechanic findings and previous issues I recommend the vehicle be declared surplus and be sold ASAP. The new ambulance to replace M301 is expected to be delivered January 2023. Working on options for earlier delivery.
- 5. T304 service and repair is finally complete, delays due to parts shortage. Pump overheating and primer issues have been resolved.
