Call Volume:

Calls since last meeting: 53. 33 EMS, 20 Fire

Total Fire and EMS Calls 2023 year to date are: 180

<u>Training:</u>

- 1. New hire orientation continues.
- 2. Monthly EMS training completed, taught by AirEvac

Wildland:

- 1. Multiple trainings scheduled around the region with SPFD personnel attending and/or teaching.
- 2. DFFM Continues to regularly stage resources at the Richland Station.
- 3. The weather has been and will continue to be favorable for fires. We are getting more frequent calls for wildland incidents.

Out of District Services:

Emergency Medical Services:

- 1. New M301 is back from the shop and in service.
- 2. Ambulance rate increase packet was submitted, awaiting response.

Hazardous Materials and Technical Rescue:

1. HazMat FRO class has been requested and scheduled for August. Class will be taught in Willcox to help engage regional partners.

Maintenance

- 1. There are 12 pending apparatus work orders.
- 2. There are 3 equipment work order.
- 3. The station roof still needs replaced. USDA loan/grant application is submitted.
