Call Volume:

<u>Training:</u>

- 1. New hire orientation continues.
- 2. Two employees have finished the firefighter I&II academy at Cochise Community College.
- 3. I completed my Fire Officer II course with SVFMS.
- 4. Monthly EMS training completed, taught by AirEvac. Monthly fire training will be held here tomorrow.

Wildland:

- 1. DFFM Continues to regularly stage resources at the Richland Station.
- 2. The weather has been and will continue to be favorable for fires. We are getting more frequent calls for wildland incidents. We have had a few multi-day assignments during the last few weeks. Moving forward lightning will be a concern for us.

Out of District Services:

1. Exploring annexation options as requested by surrounding community members.

Emergency Medical Services:

1. Ambulance rate increase packet was re-submitted with changes as requested by AZDHS, awaiting response.

Hazardous Materials and Technical Rescue:

1. HazMat FRO class has been requested and scheduled for August. Class will be taught in Willcox to help engage regional partners.
