### Fire Chief's Report for November 21, 2023

#### Call Volume:

Calls since last meeting: 76 EMS: 54 Fire: 22 Total Fire and EMS Calls for 2023: 639

### <u>Training:</u>

- 1. Monthly in-house medical training completed on care of neonatal emergency care.
- 2. Completed a rope rescue class with 5 employees becoming certified at the operations level.
- 3. Chief Garner and Lieutenant Friedenberg completed Fire Instructor II with SVFMS.

## Wildland:

- 1. E308 responded to California for a preposition assignment for 8 days.
- 2. We are about 40% of the way through the fiscal year and have billed over 95% of expected wildland revenue.
- 3. Planning multiple training courses for the off season.
- 4. Austin Garner was approved as a qualified ENGB by the state red card committee.

## **Out of District Services:**

1. Met with citizens in the Dragoon community on 11/11/23 and provided them information on fire readiness and on response procedures for their area. There was discussion of possible annexation, with that topic on the agenda tonight.

#### **Emergency Medical Services:**

1. The ambulance rate increase packet was re-submitted with changes as requested by AZDHS, still awaiting a response.

## Hazardous Materials and Technical Rescue:

1. Operations level rope rescue class hosted Oct 23<sup>rd</sup>-25<sup>th</sup> was a success.
