## Fire Chief's Report for April 15, 2025

## Call Volume as of March 31st:

February Call Volume: 63 Fire: 8 EMS: 55

**2025:** 220

#### **Training:**

- 1. EMS training completed reviewing pediatric emergencies
- 2. On duty training continues at the shift level on various topics.
- 3. Wildland training continues daily in preparation for the upcoming season.

#### Wildland:

- 1. Forecasts indicate Cochise County is expected to see above average temperatures, below average moisture and above normal fire activity for through June.
- 2. We have seen an increase in fires, especially on RED FLAG days.

#### **Out of District Services:**

1. Dragoon annexation meeting had to be re-scheduled. Will follow up when new date is set.

#### **Emergency Medical Services:**

1. Call volume and transports are up. Exploring options for increased staffing if call volume continues to climb. 2024 saw a 19% increase in call volume. We are on pace to see another 20% increase in volume.

1. Station and vehicle maintenance continues.

#### **Communications:**

- 1. Fire danger sign with indicators for no burn days has arrived. Working with county roads on permit for installation.
- 2. Annual Open house is set for May 10<sup>th</sup>

#### <u>Staffing</u>

- 1. One fulltime position is currently open, being filled with part-timers until a qualified applicant can be found.
- 2. Additional hiring and orientation is underway to meet the demands of our increased call volume and expected spring/summer fire activity. We have had 4 paramedics apply in the last month
- 3. Part-time and volunteer staff have been engaged in training and picking up shifts.
- 4. Anticipate adding at least one full-time position next fiscal year and increasing available part-time hours.
